

Advertisement: Call for Nominations to Serve on the IRBA's Monitoring Committee:

Individual with legal background

The IRBA hereby calls for nominations/applications onto its Monitoring Committee (MCOM), which is a subcommittee of the Education, Training and Professional Development Committee (EDCOM).

MCOM is responsible for the monitoring of accredited professional bodies and evaluates them against the requirements in the IRBA's [Accreditation Model](#).

This appointment is for a committee member with a background in law, specifically in the field of commercial law as a practicing professional. In making its decision on who should serve on MCOM, EDCOM shall consider, among others, the following:

- Independence in mind, fact and appearance;
- Qualifications;
- Professional affiliations;
- Skills and experience (including legal experience);
- Race and gender.

Applicants' independence will also be assessed against their association to the IRBA's accredited professional bodies.

Applicants are required to have legal experience and interest in the field of education, training and the professional development of professional accountants/auditors, and/or accreditation and monitoring of professional bodies/organisations.

The term of office of MCOM members shall be three years, renewable once at the EDCOM's discretion.

Eligible persons who meet the criteria, and who wish to be considered for appointment, are invited to submit their applications (Nomination form and detailed CV) by email to:
