

*Call for Nominations to Serve on the IRBA's Monitoring Committee:*

*One (1) Individual with Current AGSA Experience at Senior level*

The Independent Regulatory Board for Auditors (IRBA) is a statutory body established in terms of Section 3 of the Auditing Profession Act (Act No. 26 of 2005), as amended.

Its functions with regard to the accreditation of professional bodies are established in section 5 and section 7(1)(a) and (b) of the Act. Accredited professional bodies must satisfy the IRBA that they continue to comply with the requirements for accreditation in order to retain accreditation, as noted in section 34 of the Act.

The Education, Training and Professional Development Committee (EDCOM) is established in terms of section 20(2) (c) of the Act and its duties include those relating to the accreditation and monitoring of professional bodies. To this end, EDCOM has established the **Monitoring Committee (MCOM), as its subcommittee responsible for the monitoring of accredited professional bodies.**

MCOM evaluates the accreditation of the professional body against the requirements in the IRBA's [Accreditation Model](#).

The IRBA hereby calls for nominations onto the MCOM. In making its decision on who should serve on MCOM, EDCOM shall consider, among others, the following:

- Independence in mind, fact and appearance.
- Qualifications.
- Professional affiliations.
- Skills and experience.
- Race and gender.

**Applicants' independence will be assessed against their association to accredited professional bodies (for example if you serve on the governance structures or are an employee of an accredited professional body, this will impede your independence.)**

Applicants are required to have experience and interest in the field of education, training and the professional development of professional accountants and auditors, and/or accreditation and monitoring of professional bodies/organisations/programmes.

In addition, the following experience is required for this appointment:

- Senior-level experience with the Auditor General South Africa (AGSA): A minimum of 5 years in a senior role within the AGSA environment.
- Exposure to trainees from both ACCA and SAICA: Familiarity with working alongside or mentoring trainees from both professional bodies.
- Experience in the training and development environment: Proven background in training and development.
- Strategic knowledge and experience: Strong strategic acumen and practical experience in strategic roles.
- Registered Auditor (RA): Preferably hold a RA designation.

The term of office of MCOM members shall be three years, renewable once at the EDCOM's discretion.

Eligible persons who meet the criteria, and who wish to be considered for appointment, are invited to submit their applications by email to:

Each application must include a **curriculum vitae** detailing the applicant's knowledge, experience and suitability as a committee member and a **completed nomination form**, which can be downloaded from the IRBA website at [Committee application/nomination form](#). Please include a copy of your **highest qualification** with your application as well.

After the closing date, applications that meet the criteria set out above will be evaluated for the final decision to be made by the EDCOM, subject to background checks.
